4.1.6 - Filling of Vacancies: Whenever a vacancy occurs on the committee, the remaining members of the committee shall select a voter of the town to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term.

Proposed Language:

4.1.6 - Filling of Vacancies: Whenever a vacancy occurs on the committee, it shall be filled in the manner set forth in Section 4.1.3 above.

ADJOURNED ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

May 28, 1992

Pursuant to the vote of adjournment on May 21, 1992, the Town Meeting Members met at the Town Hall on Thursday, May 28, 1992, notices having been sent to members absent at the previous meeting.

A list of duly qualified Town Meeting Members was used at the entrance of the meeting place. The list contained the names of one hundred ninety-two (192) Town Meeting Members entitled to vote and participate in Town Meeting in Winchester.

A check list filed with the Town Clerk at the close of the meeting showed that one hundred sixty-eight (168) Town Meeting Members attended the meeting.

After a brief prayer and a moment of silence to honor William P. Haggerty, town hall custodian who died on May 24, 1992, the Moderator called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

The Moderator announced that a motion to reconsider Article 27 had been submitted and would be put before the meeting as the first order of business at the next session or, if the meeting would conclude this evening, the last order of business tonight.
